RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The team fee for this event is FREE as a special introductory rate on a first-come, first serve basis, as long as openings last.
- There will be two (2) age group divisions:
 - a. Middle School Students
 - b. High School Students
- Each team will consist of one child and one parent/guardian. The parent/guardian must be present with the child during the entire process.
- The child must do the preparation, cooking, and presentation. If a child is unable to do the above on their own, they are too young to participate. However, parents may help with fires, slicing or anything considered dangerous.
- All children will cook in a designated area on grills provided by Pig on the Pond.
- Entries will be submitted in numbered containers provided by Pig on the Pond.
- Garnish (lettuce/parsley/kale) is permitted but must be supplied by the contestants themselves.
- Slicing the meat for presentation is not required. Judges will be equipped to slice the presentation at the judging table.
- Judging will be based on APPEARANCE, TENDERNESS, TEXTURE, AND TASTE.
- Judging ranges from ten (10) being the highest to one (1) being the lowest.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

DEFINITION OF FOOD CATEGORIES

CHICKEN: Chicken will be provided and must be used in the competition.

STEAK: Steak will be provided and must be used in the competition.

Upon arrival, check-in at the registration area (Highlander Building gate) for your space assignment. A special area will be designated for the competition.

JUNIOR GRILLMASTERS COMPETITION COOKS MEETING

At 10:45 AM, Sunday, October 17, 2021, participants must meet in the middle of the competition area. (It is mandatory for the competitor and parent/guardian to attend this meeting for a safety briefing by the Groveland Fire Department and to pick up your food containers.)

SUPPLIES

Thanks to Publix, which will supply the following to each competitor:

- 14-inch round portable charcoal grill (that you will get to take home)
- Tongs
- Publix Instant Light Charcoal Briquets
- Stick lighter
- Publix boneless, skinless chicken breast (individually wrapped and similar weight)
- Publix premium beef New York strip steak boneless (individually wrapped and similar weight)

Contestants must supply their own cooking ingredients (other than meat; such as seasoning, sauces), cooking utensils (other than tongs) and must cook on the grill provided. Teams will also be provided a preparation table to assist with the competition. Other helpful items to bring include: paper towels, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, and cutting boards.
